



Holsworthy Branch – Gift Aid Form 2010

Because it is a charity, DBKA can now reclaim the tax that members have paid on subscriptions. Currently this means over £8 extra on the full member's subscription. So that the association can reclaim the tax, each member must have paid tax on the subscription and must complete a Gift Aid form. A gift aid form completed in previous years is still valid.

Please treat all donations and membership subscriptions that I have made in the past six years as Gift Aid Donations.

You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax in each tax year at least equal to the amount of tax the association will claim from HM Revenue & Customs on your donations.

Tax claimed by the association

- The association will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The association will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to the association an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the association does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
