Bee Diseases Insurance (BDI)

The BDI scheme covers losses due to notifiable bee diseases. The basic subscriptions for full and partner members includes insurance for 3 colonies. If you intend to keep more colonies than this at anytime during the season you must pay extra as shown below. Note that the total includes nucs and mini-nucs

Gift Aid
